Coastal Plains Plus Guidelines and Agreement - FY 24

Coastal Plains Plus is designed as a community benefit for older students that are no longer able to receive FTE state funding. The following criteria apply to those interested.

- The District Counselor will complete the evaluation and list all courses needed to meet graduation requirements.
- Students are eligible if 5 credits or fewer are required for a high school diploma
- There is no age limit for Coastal Plains Plus.
- Hours of attendance will be set by Site Directors based on seating availability.
- Graduation Coaches will monitor course completion and communicate with students when they are in need of addition support.
- Student discipline standards for all Coastal Plains students are expected for those enrolled in Coastal Plains Plus. See Student Handbook for complete information.
- See Superintendent or Regional Director for Student Services regarding extenuating circumstances.
